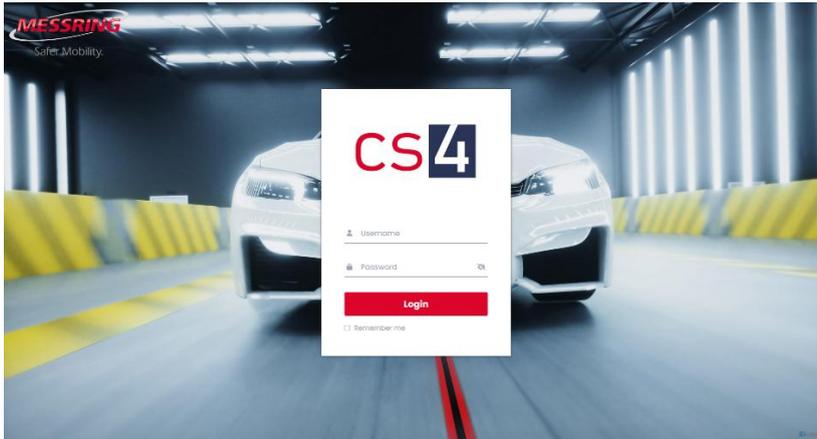
### **Crash Day: Live Demo and Crash Test**
